The round shot was the traditional one (three dozen arrows each at three distances). Rounds shot included the St George (100, 80 and 60), Albion (80, 60

and 50) and the Windsor family.

Mathew shot a PB (and new Club Record for the Junior Boy Under 18 group) for the Junior Windsor Round with a score of 723, 1546 on handicap. It also beat his previous year's score by almost 200 points so a great round of shooting and well deserving of the award.

Winter Shooting

For the fourth year running we have booked a number of sessions for Indoor Shooting over the Winter months at St Edmunds Church Hall in Roundhay. Dates booked are as follows, all on a Saturday afternoon 1pm-4pm. November 20th, December 18th, January 15th, and February 12th.

We will be shooting a Portsmouth round (5 dozen arrows at 20 yards). We cannot promise wind, rain, or mud, but it should still be fun. The reason for having four shoots is so you can get an indoor handicap (if you so wish) from the first three weeks and then shoot for the Indoor Handicap Trophy on the last Saturday (current holder Pete Hine). Any questions get in touch with Pete (p.j.hine@leeds.ac.uk). We will continue to offer indoor badges for achievement at the Portsmouth Round. See Pete if you get a score of 300 to 575 in increments of 25, or 580 to 600 (the maximum possible) in increments of 5. These badges cost £2 each.

Shooting will (of course) still continue outdoors throughout the winter. You could join the team shooting 'Clout' (usually Bill, Phil, Brian and Anthony) on a Saturday morning; they shoot in all weathers.

There is also likely to be some target shooting of a Saturday afternoon (often Nigel and Colin) if the weather is not too bad.

Finally, don't forget the Field Shoot Fun Shoot that Bill has organised for Saturday 16th October. Either email Bill or put your name on the list in the right hand container: cost £3
